Large Quilts, assembled and quilted by exhibitor (non professional), 275" and larger outside dimension. Choose one category.

- Pieced, predominant construction technique
- Appliqué, predominant construction technique
- Hand quilted (pieced and/or appliqué)

Large Quilts, assembled by exhibitor, quilted by a professional or 2nd party, 275" and larger outside dimension. Choose one category.

- Pieced, predominant construction technique
- Appliqué, predominant construction technique

Medium Quilts, assembled and quilted by exhibitor (non professional), 150-274" total outside dimension, Choose one category.

- Pieced, predominant construction technique
- Appliqué, predominant construction technique
- Hand quilted (pieced and/or appliqué)

Medium Quilts, assembled by exhibitor, quilted by a professional or 2nd party, 150-274" total outside dimension. Choose one category.

- Pieced, predominant construction technique
- Appliqué, predominant construction technique

Small Quilts, assembled by exhibitor, quilted by exhibitor, professional, or 2nd party, less than 150" total outside dimension. Choose one category.

- Pieced, predominant construction technique
- Appliqué, predominant construction technique
- Hand quilted (pieced and/or appliqué)

Group Quilts assembled or quilted by 3 or more people, such as row robin quilts, block exchange quilts, group hand quilted quilts.

Miniature Quilts, NOT just a small quilt, but a miniature version of a larger quilt. Not to exceed 120" total outside dimension. Blocks of a pieced miniature must not exceed 4".

Innovative/Art Quilts, an original design, a creative interpretation, something different. Not made from a published pattern.

Miscellaneous, garments, purses, totes, table runners, pillows, etc.
