Christmas Placemat Project – Shirley Gilmore showed a sample placemat. Placemats would be brought to potlucks and hung at quilt show in the cafeteria. Placemat directions will be put on the website. Finished placemats should be brought to the June or July meeting so they can be hung at the Quilt Show and will be returned at the September meeting. A suggestion was made to use flannel instead of batting so that glasses sit better on the placemat. Perhaps a placemat exchange at the potluck?

Community Quilts – Phoebe Hein reminded the membership that Community Quilts are a way to give back to the community. We need 6 people to volunteer to be on the committee and commit to show up at worksite on project days. We need a space for meeting. Phoebe talked with Ruth about possibly having the Community Quilt meetings in her Waldport shop. It would be a great space to work in and there is storage space in the back of the store for the
